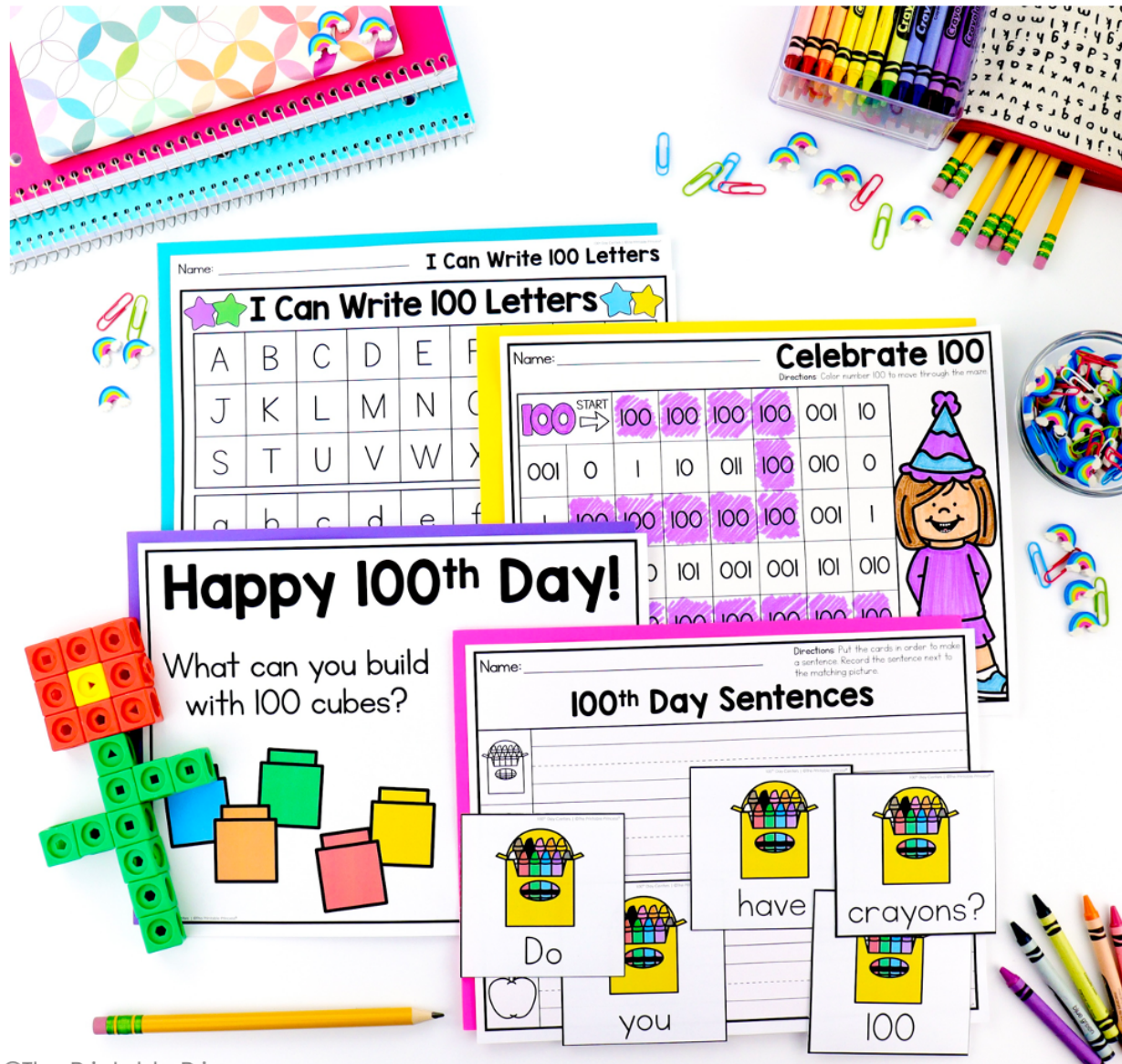


# 100<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF SCHOOL MADE FOR KINDERGARTEN

# What's included?

# 100th DAY CENTERS

**RFK1b, LK1a Write the Room**  
**Prep Work:** Print, cut apart, and laminate word cards. Print the recording sheet "Write the Room". Students will need something to write on, such as a clipboard.  
**Directions:** Prior to beginning the activity, place cards in various spots around the room. Students will walk around the room to find the cards. As students find the cards, they will match the picture on the card to the picture on their paper and record the word.

**Write the Room**  
 Directions: Record the word next to the matching picture.

**KCCA1 Mystery Picture**  
**Prep Work:** Print, laminate, and cut apart the number cards. Print the recording sheet "Mystery Pictures". **Note:** The green and purple cards are optional and do not affect the outcome of the puzzle. If you only have a short amount of time, use only the blue, red, and yellow cards.  
**Directions:** Students will select a card and find the number on their paper. They will color the number square to match the background of the card.
