


#### About this packet...


**Build the Number I**: There are two versions of mats included. Print the activity mats and cut apart. Students will use mini erasers {or other manipulatives} to form the number on the activity mats. For one version, students will use a dry erase marker to trace the numbers at the bottom.


**Build the Number 2**: Print the work mats and slide in page protectors. Print, cut, and laminate the number cards. Students will select a card, determine the teen number represented, and form the number on the mat.


**Build the Number 3**: Print and cut apart the activity mats. Students will determine the number represented by the three pictures and use mini erasers to form the number.

**Build the Number 4**: {Great for guided math!} Print and cut apart the mats. Students will use mini erasers to form the numbers.









### Build the Number I


Students will use small erasers, plastic linking cubes, or other small classroom manipulatives to form the numbers.


Using a dry erase marker, students will write the numbers at the bottom.

Students will identify the number represented on the picture card. They will use small erasers, plastic linking cubes, or other small classroom manipulatives to build the number on the ten








Includes four sets of picture cards and work mats.
