

Step 1 — Students
determine the beginning
sound of each picture to
create a CVCe word.
Next, they read the word
that they created and
blend it together to
identify the CVCe word.

Step 2 — They find the corresponding CVCe picture and match it to the secret code mat.

Step 3 — (Optional)
Students record the
CVCe word and draw a
picture to match.

This activity makes a great word work center, morning tub activity, or fast finisher project. It can most definitely be used without the recording sheet option.


Secret CVCe Words

Prep Work: Print, cut, and laminate the activity cards and picture cards. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. (Note: There are three different "I Can" pages included.)
Print and laminate the "Beginning Sound Alphabet Chart". Print the recording sheet, if using (two options included).


Directions: Students will identify the beginning sound of each picture to spell a CVCe word. They use dry erase markers or magnetic letters to spell the word on the activity mat then they will match the picture card to the CVCe card.

Beginning Sound Picture Names:

ambulance, button, cold, doll, elbow, feet, gas, hoop, insect, jellyfish, key, lock, money, numbers, octopus, pumpkin, queen, ring, sing, taco, under, van, wagon, x-ray, yarn, zipper
