
# Color Centers

15 Center Activities Included



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#### About this resource...

This resource includes 15 different center activities to teach color recognition and color words. A few of the activities have multiple versions for a total of 22 centers. Most centers focus on the basic colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, brown, and black. A few of the centers include white, pink and gray/grey.

This resource is designed to offer students hands-on and engaging ways to practice color words. You can use these activities in a small group lesson or independent work station. Some of the activities do not require a recording sheet and would be great for a morning tub or fast finisher activity.

The activities are simple to prep. Just print, laminate, and cut. Each center includes a student friendly "I Can" visual directions page. You can either print the recording sheets for students to record their work and turn in, or print and slide in a page protector and have students use dry eraser markers and color-code counters to mark their answers. Answer Keys are available at the end of this resource for easy checking. A student color words reference page is available on page 104 - 105 and can be used with any of the centers.

**Note:** The picture cards for the three activities entitled "Roll, Color, Graph", are meant to be used with the "Differentiated Instruction Cubes" which are available on Amazon. Or you can use the cube template, which is also included.

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#### Paint a Rainbow

Print, cut, and laminate the spinner page. Print the recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. Students will need crayons, colored pencils, markers or bingo dabbers for this activity. Students can use a paperclip and pencil to make a spinner or a plastic pre-made spinner.


Directions: Students will spin the spinner and identify the color. On the recording sheet, they will color a real life object to match.
Students will continue to spin and color until all of the pictures have been colored.



### Animals Among Us

Print, cut, and laminate the spinner page. Print the recording sheet.
Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. Students will need crayons, colored pencils, markers or bingo dabbers for this activity. Students can use a paperclip and pencil to make a spinner or a plastic pre-made spinner.

Directions: Students will spin the spinner and identify the color word. On the recording sheet, they will color a box with the corresponding color word. Students will continue to spin and color until all of the spaces have been colored.




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
#### Write the Room

Print, cut, and laminate the picture cards. Print the recording sheet.

Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. Note: There are two versions of the recording sheets included. A version with handwriting lines is included with the picture cards.

Directions: Place cards in various places around the classroom.
Students will walk around the room to find the cards. They will match the picture on the card to the picture on their recording sheet.
They will copy the word from the card and write it on their paper.






### Crayon Colors

Print, cut, and laminate the picture cards. Print the recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. Students will need crayons, colored pencils, or markers for this activity.

Directions: You can use this as a write the room activity or have students complete in a center.


Students will select a picture card and identify the color word. They will find the corresponding color word on the paper. They will trace the color word and color the crayon to match.



### Sentence Shuffle

To prepare this activity print, laminate, and cut apart the sentence cards. Print the recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page.


Directions: Students will select a set of cards with the same picture. They will put the cards in order to make a complete sentence. To record their work, they will find the matching picture and record the sentence on the line.



#### Colorful Sentences

To prepare this activity print, laminate, and cut apart the sentence cards. Print the recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page.


Directions: Students will put the cards in order to make a complete sentence. To record their work, they will find the matching color word and trace it and color the pig to match.



#### Count and Color

Print, cut, and laminate the directions mat. Print the corresponding recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. Students will need crayons for this activity. **Note:** There are two activities included.

Directions: Students will read each color statement and color the corresponding number of objects to match the color statement




#### What Color Is It?

Print, cut, and laminate the picture cards. Print the corresponding recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page.

Note: There are three activities included.


Directions: Students will identify the picture and real world color. On the recording sheet they will write the name of the picture under the corresponding color.



#### Secret Code Color Words

Print, cut, and laminate the secret code cards. Print the corresponding recording sheet. Print and laminate the reference page and "I Can" visual directions page.


Directions: Students will identify the beginning sound of each picture to spell a color word. They will record the color word on the recording sheet next to the matching letter.



### Colorful Clips

Print, cut, and laminate the clip cards. Print the corresponding recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. Students will need clothespins or small manipulatives for this activity.


Directions: Students will identify the color of each picture. They will clip or cover the color word. On the recording sheet, they will find the matching picture and record the color word.



#### Colorful Hearts

Print, cut, and laminate the picture cards. Print the corresponding recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page.


Directions: Students will select a heart card and identify the color. On the recording sheet they will color a heart to match and write the color word.



## Roll, Color, Graph

Print, cut, and laminate the picture cards and slide in a plastic pocket cube or put the cube template together. Print the corresponding recording sheet. Print and laminate the reference page and "I Can" visual directions page. Note: There are two activities included.


Directions: Students will roll the cube and color a space to show the color they rolled.



#### Paint a Color Word

Print, cut, and laminate the activity cards. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page. Print, laminate, and cut apart color word reference page, if using. Print the recording sheet "Paint a Color Word".

Directions: Students will select an activity card and count each color of paint. On the recording sheet, students will write the color word next to the matching number.




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### Let's Graph Color Words

Print the color mat, corresponding recording sheet, and "I Can" visual directions. **Note**: There are two activities included.

Students will count each set of color objects on the graphing mat. They will color the graph to show the total of each color. They will use their graph to answer questions and then spell the color words on the paper.

Tip: For students who need extra support, have them place a plastic math cube over each picture they are counting. This will help them know which pictures they have already counted. Once they are finished counting the object, they remove the counters and start again with the next picture.



#### Color Word Scramble

To prepare this activity print, laminate, and cut apart the color word cards. Print the recording sheet. Print and laminate the "I Can" visual directions page.

Directions: Students will select a set of letter cards with the same color on the upper right corner. They will put the cards in order to spell the color word. On the recording sheet, they will write the color word and color the shape to match.
