

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About this resource...

This activity was designed to help students identify numbers in various forms and to help them practice counting on from a given number (to 20).

There are 126 number cards included for numbers 0 – 20 (6 cards for each numbers). Students can show the missing numbers using magnetic numbers, dry erase markers, or the number cards included on page 4.


To prepare this activity decide if you want to use Number Cards 0 to 10 or Number Cards 11 – 20. Print, laminate, and cut apart the activity cards. You may choose to only use numbers to 5 or 10 at the beginning of the year. Then introduce teen numbers later in the year.


Students will select an activity card. They will identify the number represented in the first space on the card. They will count on to determine the missing numbers. They will show the missing numbers on the mat.

It is recommended that you do not put out all of the number cards at one time. You may want to only put out 15-20 cards at a time, depending on how many students are working in the group.









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
