Sight Word Trail Game

To prepare this activity, use the next page to type in the sight words your class is working on. Print and laminate the game mats.

Students will each need a game piece such as a mini eraser or plastic cube for this activity. They will also need a plastic spinner or a paperclip and pencil to make a spinner.

This game can be played with a partner or a small group. These are quick games which are perfect for morning tubs, early finishers, or as time fillers.

Students will start on the first space in the upper left corner of the game board. They will spin the spinner and read the sight word. They will read the sight words on the trail and move their game piece to the nearest space that matches the sight word they spun. The gray shaded themed spaces are free spaces.

The first player to make it all the way around to the last space on the game board is the winner. To win the game, the player must spin the final sight word shown in the last space on the game board.



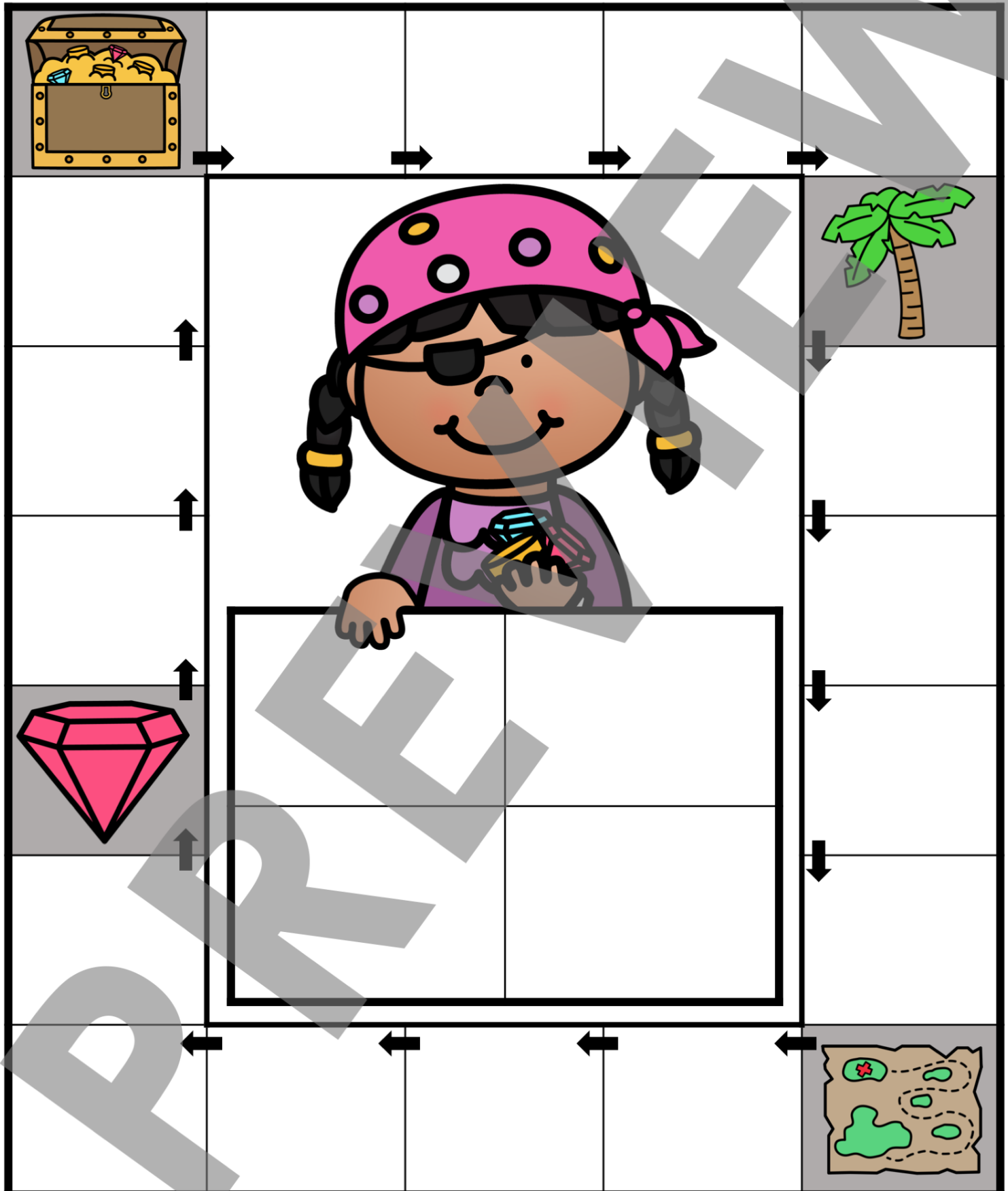
