
To prep this activity, all you need to do is print! Students will need a paperclip and a pencil to make

a spinner.

Students will make a spinner and then spin it. They will determine whether the letter they spun is an uppercase or lowercase letter.


They will record the letter in the space and then spin again. They will continue spinning and recording their spins until the page is full or until time is up.

When printing this activity, be sure to select "scale to fit page" or "fit" in your printer settings. This will ensure that all of the black margins appear on the pages.




