

About this resource...

The pages included in this resource are all no prep activities. This means that the only prep needed is to just print! For a few of the activities students will need a spinner or a dot cube to complete. One of the activities requires construction paper for students to tear and glue.


You will find two "types" of pages in this resource. One type focuses on only one color at a time. The second type, beginning on page 83, focuses on a variety of colors and color words.

Directions are listed on each page, with the exception of pg 5 – 16 and 17 – 28 (due to space). Those directions are listed below:

Pg 5 – 16, Flip Books: To make these flip books, students will color the pictures and cut the page in half on the dotted line. They will then cut the four pictures on the right side apart. They will stack the pages on the left and have an adult staple the pictures on the book.

Pg 17 – 28, Mini Readers: Students will color the pictures and trace the color word. Students will fold the book in half longways (or a hot-dog fold). Next students will fold the book in half again (or a hamburger fold).




