
# NUMBER FLIP BOOKS

Includes flip books for numbers 1 – 20 and an extension activity.









### Includes

- Kid-Friendly "I Can" Visual Directions
- Numbered Direction Cards
- Flip Books for Numbers I 20
- Skills Include: Number Writing, Ten Frames, One-to-One Correspondence, Tally Marks, and more.
- Optional Recording Sheet

## **Directions**:

Each student will need one copy of the book. They can color the pictures and rainbow write the dotted letters. Students will cut the page in half, along the dotted line. (See examples to the right.)

Students will then cut each of the 4 pictures {from the right side} apart.

### Do not cut out the picture from the left side.

Students will then stack the four cut out pictures on top of the picture on the left side. It doesn't matter the order, but as you will notice the bottom picture has a marking to show where to put the staple, so I tell students that one should go on top.


Students can either place a small amount of glue in the shaded space designated, or an adult can put a single staple on the side of the pictures to keep them in place.


If you are using this activity in a center, or simply wish to extend the flipbook, there is an extension page in the back that you can use.

#### Included to show students how to cut apart book:

-"I Can" chart to promote independence when working at a center.

-Picture cards which can be cut and placed on the board for visual directions.
