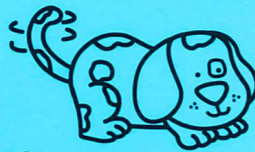

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About this resource...

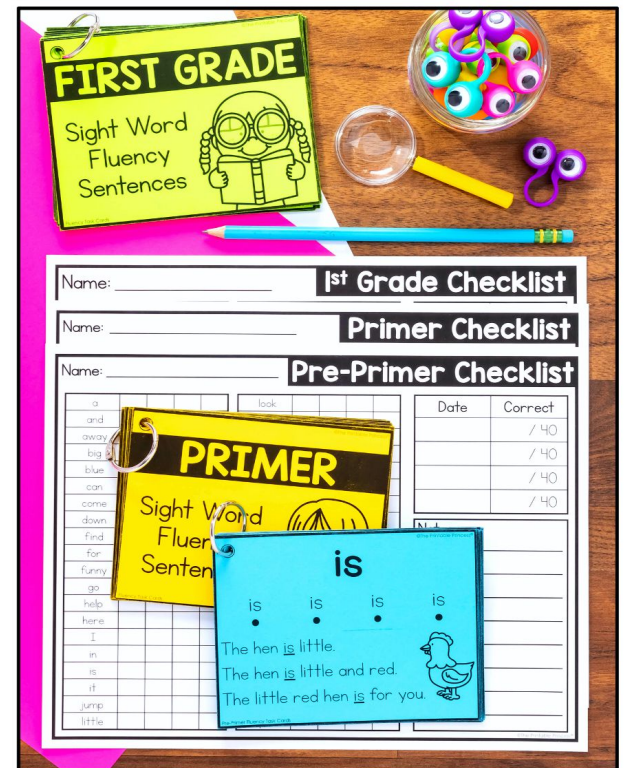
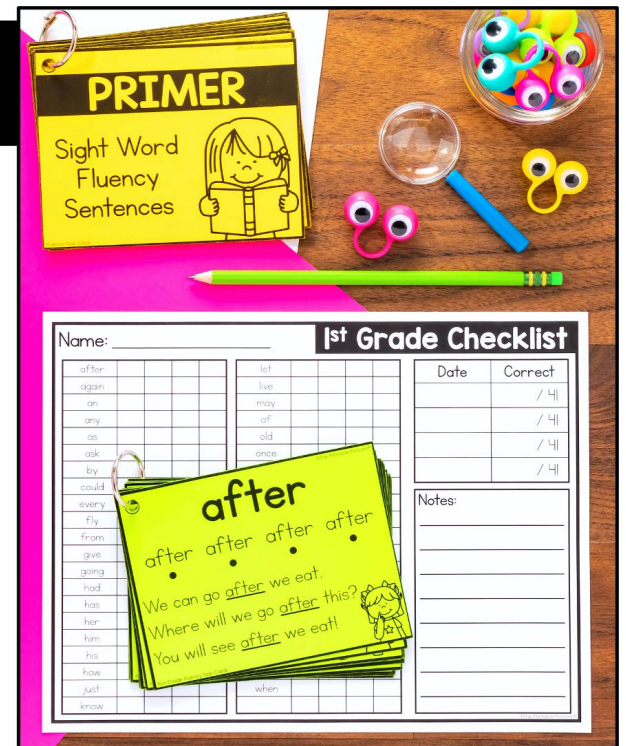
This fluency resource was designed to help students practice sight word fluency. There are three sight word fluency task card sets included for Pre-Primer, Primer, and First Grade word lists along with the corresponding assessment sheets.

The target sight word is displayed four times at the top of each task card. Students will point and read each word before moving to the fluency sentences. Sentences cover the targeted sight word as well as developmentally appropriate spelling features.

Also included are multi-use assessment sheets for easy visual progress comparison. To use these pages, you can check off the task cards that students are able to read fluently.

To prepare this activity print, laminate and cut apart the task cards. Optional front covers are included on page 8. This activity does not require any additional materials. However, you can add pointers or other fun manipulatives to help students engage in the activity. You can also print a set for each student and as they learn each sight word, highlight the word in the sentence.

Use these cards as a warm-up for your small group, as an independent center, or for fast finishers who need to keep busy. You can even challenge your students to complete the set with a sand timer!

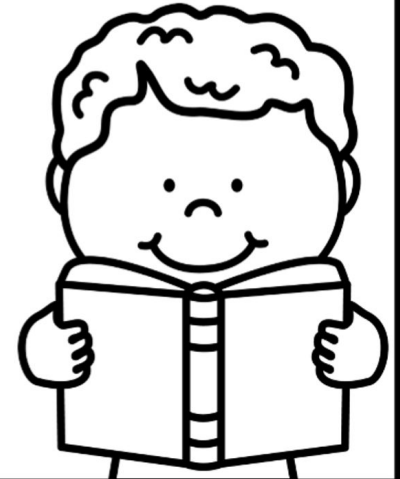

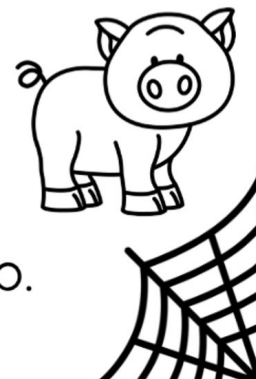

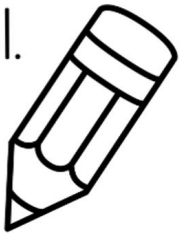
