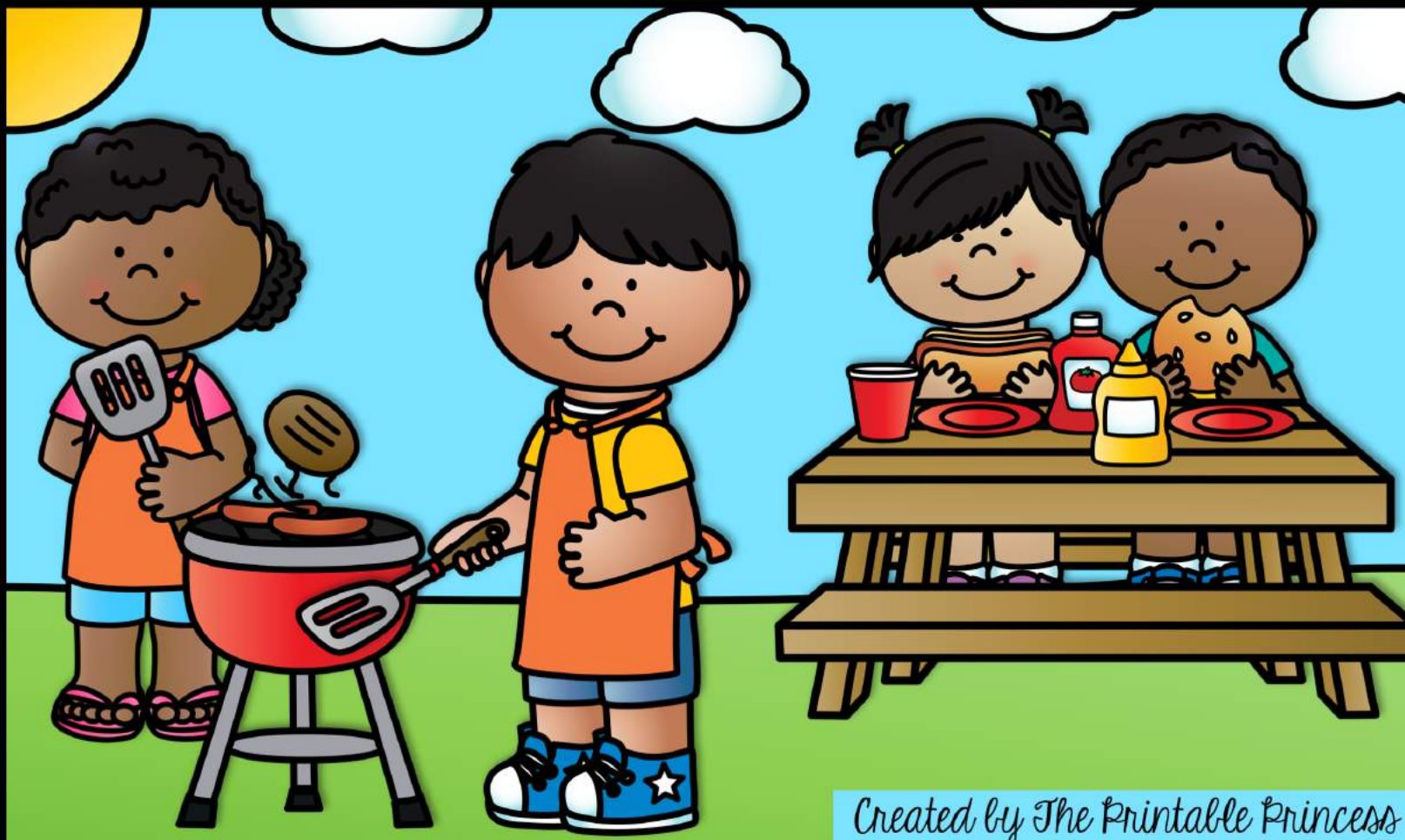


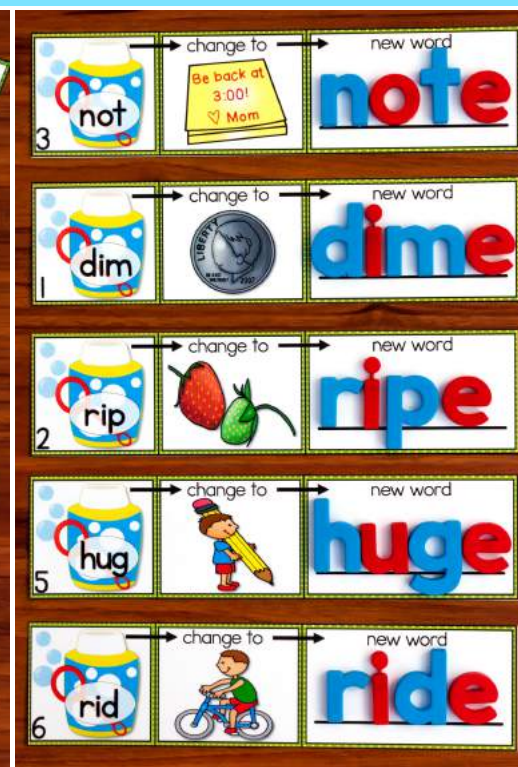
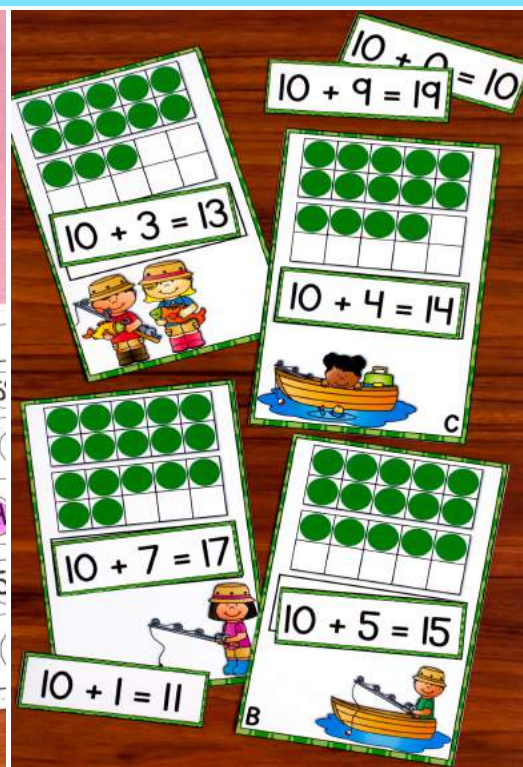

**K.OA.A.2 Summer Subtraction**

Prep Work: Print, cut, and laminate activity cards and “I Can” poster. Print the recording sheet “Summer Subtraction”.

**K.CC.A.2 Count On and Dab**

Prep Work: Print, cut, and laminate activity cards, “I Can” poster, and “Count On and Dab” recording sheet. You will need bingo dabbers for this activity. Note: There are two sets of cards. Cards with pictures of kids and ice cream only focus on numbers to 20. Cards with pictures of ice cream focus on numbers to 100 (for students who need a challenge). Make sure the recording sheet matches the cards.

Directions: Students will start counting with the number on the left side of the card. They will use the pictures on the right side to count on. To record their answer, students will match the letter on the card to their paper. They will dab the number that matches their sheet.

**K.OA.A.4 Let's Make Ten**

Prep Work: Print, cut, and laminate activity cards, addition sentence cards, “I Can” poster, and “Let's Make Ten” recording sheet.

Directions: Students will match the activity card to the addition sentence to show a way to make ten. To record their answers, they will match the letter on the ten frame card to their paper. They will record the addition sentence that matches the card.

**K.NBT.A.1 Fishin' for Ten Frames**

Prep Work: Print, cut, and laminate ten frames, activity cards, small addition sentence cards, “I Can” poster, and recording sheet “Fishin' for Ten Frames”.

Directions: Students will match the activity card to the addition sentence. To record their answers, they will match the letter on the ten frame card to their paper. They will record the addition sentence that matches the card.

Directions: Students will determine what number is needed to complete the number bond. To record their answer, students will match the letter from the card to their paper and dab the number that completes the number bond.

Prep Work: Print, cut, and laminate counting activity cards, “I Can” poster and the recording sheet “Count and Compare”.

**K.CC.B.5 Sweet Tally Marks**

Prep Work: Print, cut, and laminate tally mark (ice cream truck) cards, popsicle cards, “I Can” poster, and “Sweet Tally Marks” recording sheet. Note: There are two sets of cards. Cards with a pink background focus on numbers to 10. Cards with a green background focus on numbers to 20. Make sure the recording sheets match the match.

Directions: Students will count the tally marks and find the popsicle card with the same number. To record their answer, they will match the number on the popsicle card to their paper and record the letter from the tally mark card. For extra practice, they will also record the tally marks in the space provided.
